

Guide lines for local manufactures of coconut oil Purchase of Raw material
Whole Kernel Dehydrated Disintegrated Coconut

1. All prospective manufactures who requires Raw material should be registered at Coconut Development Authority and Ministry of Industries in Sri Lanka
2. Raw material will be provided as per the manufacturing capacity, Storage capacity and availability of working capital of each applicant
3. The imported quantity will be distributed as for the manufactures capacity on a percentage basis (as for the available raw material)
4. Once the imported material is inspected by the relevant authorities the goods should be transported to each manufactures destination and stored safely
5. The inspections and testing will be carried out by Coconut Development Authority, Coconut Research Institute, Industrial Development Board, National Plant Quarantine Service, Sri Lanka Standards Institution, Ministry of Health Food Safety Division, and all cost should be borne by the Importer.
6. Once the goods are released from the Sri Lanka Customs and Sri Lanka Ports Authority the goods will be then transported to the manufacturing factories. The total cost of local transport related charges should be borne by the manufactures. The process of transport will be arranged by the All CEYLON Traditional Coconut oil Manufactures Association under the supervision of the Coconut Development Authority.
7. All manufactures who does not have any standards of manufacturing practice should agree to obtain one during one calendar year while process
8. All manufactures should agreed to report all stocks of Raw material received , production quantity of oil and Poonach, sales and distribution details with quantity at their factories. All such reports should be updated daily to the Coconut Development Authority and keep available of any Control Authority to inspect when required
9. All manufactures agreed not to store imported oils, manufacture or handle any substitute oils, within the said premises.

Importers, Dealers or Distributors are not eligible to obtain this Raw material.
10. The importation process of the said the raw material will be done only by BCC Lanka Limited and all payments should be made only to BCC Lanka Limited by bank issued pay order to the credit of BCC Lanka Limited
11. All manufactures should agree to provide a 20% bank guarantee at the time of placing final quantity order as per the shipment quantity allocated for each manufacture
12. It is agreed by all prospective selected Raw material buyers to settle the full payment due for the purchase to BCC Lanka Limited two days prior to the arrival of the raw material.
