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Overview

In 2022, Sri Lanka's wood and furniture industry remained a significant contributor to the country's economy, combining traditional craftsmanship with modern techniques to produce a diverse range of products.

Wood Production: Sri Lanka possesses rich forest resources, with teak, mahogany, and satinwood being among the prominent varieties. However, due to deforestation and environmental concerns, sustainable forestry practices have gained attention.

Furniture Manufacturing: The furniture manufacturing sector in Sri Lanka continued to expand, catering to both domestic and international markets. Companies in this sector focused on producing a wide array of furniture items ranging from traditional handcrafted pieces to contemporary designs.

Export Market: Sri Lanka's furniture industry significantly contributed to the country's export earnings. The sector exported a variety of furniture items to markets worldwide, including the United States, Europe, and neighboring countries in Asia.

Figure 1.3: Manufacturing of Wood and Wood Based Industry Per Head Labour Productivity






Figure 2.1: The Contribution of the Furniture Products sector to the share of the manufacturing industry to the GDP

Figure 2.3: Manufacturing of Wood and Wood Based Industry Per Head Labour Productivity


